- 1957** 1957 Full City Delivery Service:
Established with one truck.
- 1961** 1961 Norco Delivery Service Created:
Relocated to North Orange County with the addition of 7 more trucks.
- 1968** 1968 ACI & Ajac Mail Delivery Services:
Appointed an airfreight cartage company. With this contract inner-company divisions were beginning to develop. Ajac Mail Delivery Services as an identity.
- 1977** 1977 Bay Mail Delivery Services:
Purchased Bay Mail Delivery Services of Costa Mesa, CA. Norco Delivery Service's mail delivery customers now numbered over 500. Created Norco Delivery Services as an identity.
- 1992** 1992 Acquired Desmond Mail Services:
Based out of Los Angeles, Desmond serviced the community for 50 years. With this, Norco established an office in LA and became the largest mail pick up and delivery in southern California.
- 1995** 1995 Purchase of Western States:
Western States Courier became part of the Norco family. Had offices in Anaheim and Glendale.
- 1998** 1998 Action Courier Purchase:
Action Courier specializes in the title industry and is located in San Diego, CA.
- 1999** 1999 Anaheim Building:
Norco was successful in purchasing a building located in Anaheim that would not only accommodate its current needs, but offer substantial growth possibilities for the future.
- 2001** 2001 Purchase of Bradford Messenger:
Located in the Central Valley of California, Bradford Messenger Services was the first purchase outside southern California.
- 2008** 2008 Overnite Express & ASAP Corporation:
